



दतला नदी पुनर्जीवन यात्रा के समापन समारोह पर ग्रामीणों ने लिया संकल्प

कटनी, देशबन्धु। मानव जीवन में जल सर्वाधिक महत्वपूर्ण है। शहर में जहां वर्षा का जल बचाने के लिये वाटर हार्वैस्टिंग की तकनीक उपयोग में लाई जाती है तो वहीं ग्रामीण अंचलों में भी अब पानी बचाने के लिये जागरूकता बढ़ते जा रही है। माता शबरी जयंती के शुभ अवसर पर 24 फरवरी से 26 फरवरी 2021 तक चलने वाली दतला नदी पुनर्जीवन यात्रा का समापन दशरमन के मेहंदेई माता मंदिर में चल रहे मेला प्रांगण में किया गया। ग्रामीणों ने संकल्प जल संरक्षण का संकल्प लिया और गांवों का पानी गांव में ही इसकी संरचना तैयार करने पर जोर दिया गया।

इस मौके पर कार्यक्रम के संयोजक भारत नामदेव, मोहन नागवानी, पंजाब सिंह मरावी, सीताराम बेगा, अशोक धुर्वे, राम सिंह बहादुर एवं धर्मेन्द्र के साथ देवी माता मंदिर में मेला के समिति प्रबंधक रमेश गर्ग, बम्होरी के संतोष उपाध्याय, रजनीश गौतम की उपस्थिति गरिमामयी रही। इस मौके पर नदी के उद्गम स्थल



को भी पुनर्जीवित करने का संकल्प लिया गया। तालाब के पानी के स्रोत का संरक्षण करने का संकल्प लेकर खमरवानी के तालाब से यात्रा प्रारंभ होकर मुखास, छीतापाल, मझगवां, कचनारी, पाली, धनवाही, डाला, लालपुर, गोपालपुर, झारापानी, घाना, सुनार खेड़ा, बम्होरी से होते हुए दशरमन

में समापन किया गया।

इस कार्यक्रम का वृहद उद्देश्य हर गांव में जैव विविधता समितियों का गठन कर समाप्त हो रही जैव विविधता को पुनर्जीवित किया जाना एवं नदी एवं भूमि संरक्षण समिति का गठन करके रोजगार गारन्टी योजना एवं ग्रामीण आजीविका के साधनों को विस्तारित

किया जाना था। इसके अलावा यह भी संकल्प लिया गया कि प्रत्येक ग्राम का बरसात में आने वाला जल किसी को सिंचाई के लिए उपयोग नहीं करने दिया जाएगा। इसके अलावा सरकारी जमीन चारोखर की जमीन पर अवैध कब्जों को हटा कर उसमें चारागाह विकसित किया जाएगा तथा नदी से रेत की निकासी ग्राम के द्वारा बनाए गए नियमानुसार से की जायेगी।

जहां का पानी वहीं पर उपयोग

बरसाती पानी गांव के जिस हिस्से में बरसेगा उसको उसी स्थान पर रोकने का विस्तारपूर्वक प्लान तैयार किया जाएगा ताकि गांव का पानी गांव में रहे, जंगल का पानी जंगल में, मैदान का पानी मैदान में, खेत का पानी खेत में और गांव का पानी गांव में ही जमीन में ही रहे। ऐसी संरचनाओं के लिए सरकार से मदद लेकर कार्य किया जाएगा इस मौके पर जहर रहित खेती को बढ़ावा देने एवं रासायनिक खेती को बंद करने आदि बिंदुओं पर ग्रामों में चर्चा की गई।
