छोटा परिवार-सुखी परिवार के लिए किया जागरूक

केन्द्र एवं राज्य सरकार द्वारा संचालित योजना मिशन 2020 के तहत परिवार कल्याण जागरूकता कार्यक्रम का आयोजन नावकोटी के वार्ड संख्या 05 में किया गया। किरण एक प्रकाश संस्था के मार्गदर्शन में अग्रणी इंडिया की रंजू कुमारी ने उपस्थित महिलाओं को छोटा परिवार सुखी परिवार के मूल मंत्र को विस्तार से जानकारी दी। परिवार को सीमित रखने के लिए अपनाए जाने वाले तरीके यथा कापर टी लगवाना, गर्भ निरोधक गोलियों का सेवन, सूई का इस्तेमाल, पुरुषों द्वारा कंडोम का उपयोग करने आदि से होने वाले फायदे को बताया गया। छोटा परिवार, अर्थात् परिवार के बच्चे को उचित पोषण लालन-पालन, उचित शिक्षा आदि आसानी से उपलब्ध कराया जा सकता है। कम संतान के प्रजनन से माताएं भी स्वस्थ रहती हैं। इसके तहत स्थायी उपाय बंध्याकरण अथवा नसबंदी को भी अपनाया जा सकता है। मौके पर वार्ड सदस्या सुनीता देवी, रूणा देवी, कंचन देवी, फुलवती देवी, संगीता देवी, खुशबू देवी, प्रियंका देवी आदि महिलाओं ने हिस्सा लिया।

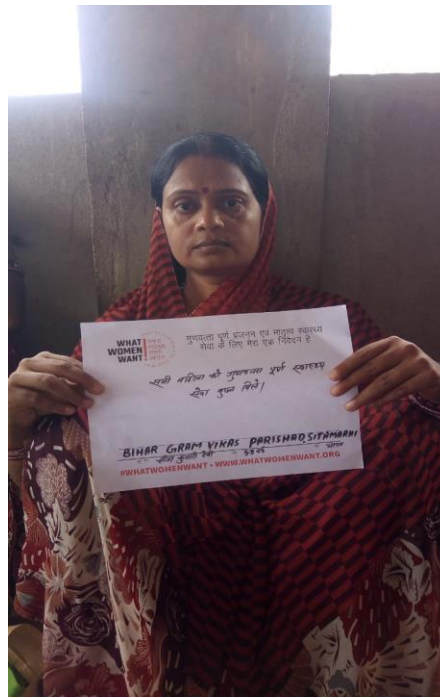
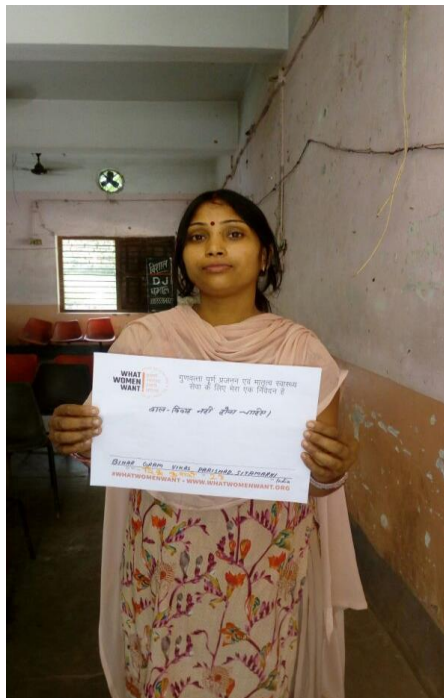

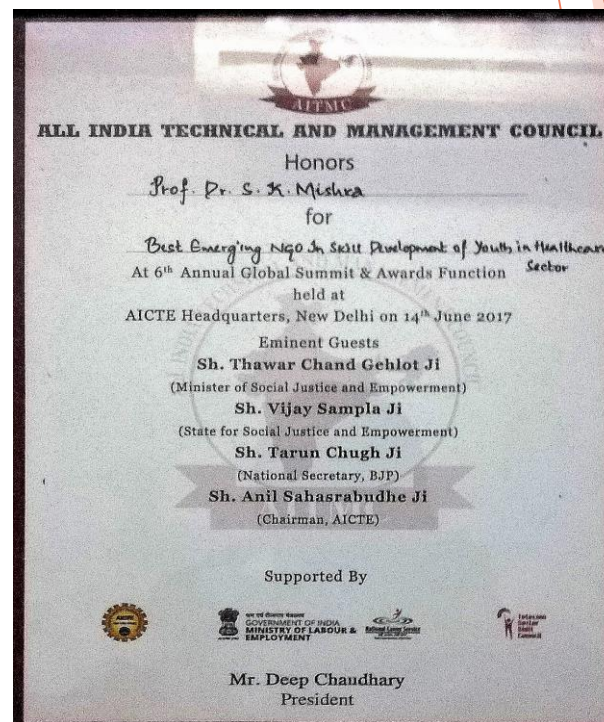
