नारी संघ परिवार द्वारा मनाया गया विश्व स्तनपान पखवाड़ा- अपराजिता सामाजिक समिति

अबूशहमा कैसरगंज
बहराइच 6 अगस्त को विजया लक्ष्मी नारी संघ की बैठक आयोजित की गई, जिसमें नारी संघ ने आंगनवाड़ी के सहयोग से विश्व स्तनपान दिवस मनाया। आंगनवाड़ी कार्यकर्ता नीतू ने महिलाओं को बताया कि विश्व स्तनपान सप्ताह हर साल 1 से 7 अगस्त तक मनाया जाता है। यह



सप्ताह स्तनपान के महत्व को प्रचारित करने और नवजात शिशुओं के लिए सही पोषण के महत्व को उजागर करने के उद्देश्य से आयोजित किया जाता है। संस्थान की सचिव किरण बैस ने नारी संघ को संबोधित करते हुए बताया कि मां को स्तनपान कराने के अनेकों फायदे हैं-

मां के दूध के फायदे-

पोषण- मां का दूध नवजात शिशु को सभी आवश्यक पोषक तत्व प्रदान करता है, जैसे प्रोटीन, वसा, कार्बोहाइड्रेट्स, विटामिन, और खनिज, जो शिशु की वृद्धि और विकास के लिए महत्वपूर्ण हैं।

प्रतिरक्षा सुरक्षा- मां के दूध में एंटीबॉडीज और अन्य

प्रतिरक्षा तत्व होते हैं जो शिशु को संक्रमण और बीमारियों से बचाते हैं। कार्यकर्ता अर्पिता ने बताया कि स्तनपान शिशु और मां के बीच भावनात्मक संबंध को मजबूत करता है, जिससे शिशु को मानसिक और भावनात्मक सुरक्षा मिलती है। नमन सोनी ने सभी नारी संघ की महिलाओं को जिम्मेदारी सौंपी कि वे यह जानकारी अन्य परिवारों तक पहुंचाएं। इसके साथ ही, आंगनवाड़ी में राशन और पोषण वितरण किया गया। इस कार्यक्रम में आंगनवाड़ी कार्यकर्ता नीतू, आशा रामकुमारी, लीडर रुबि, विजयकुमारी, प्रेमा देवी, मीरा देवी, संस्था कार्यकर्ता नमन, सोनी, जितेंद्र आदि ग्रामवासी मौजूद रहे।

फाइलेरिया से बचाव के लिए जागरूकता अभियान : मध्य विद्यालय कंकड़िया में कार्यक्रम आयोजित



बिहारशरीफ(नवशक्ति)। नूरसराय प्रखंड के अंतर्गत स्थित मध्य विद्यालय कंकड़िया में फाइलेरिया (हाथी पांव) जैसी गंभीर बीमारी के प्रति जागरूकता फैलाने के लिए एक विशेष कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया गया। इस कार्यक्रम का आयोजन मानव सेवा केन्द्र, लोहड़ी नूरसराय द्वारा संचालित किया गया, जिसमें विद्यालय के छात्रों, शिक्षकों और अभिभावकों ने भाग लिया। कार्यक्रम के दौरान, मानव सेवा केन्द्र के सचिव पुरुषोत्तम कुमार ने फाइलेरिया के बढ़ते खतरे पर चिंता जताते हुए कहा कि देश ने कोरोना जैसी महामारी से निजात पाई है, लेकिन फाइलेरिया जैसी बीमारियों से पीड़ित लोगों की संख्या दिन प्रतिदिन बढ़ती जा रही है। उन्होंने बताया कि यह इस बात का संकेत है कि लोग इस बीमारी को गंभीरता से नहीं ले रहे हैं। पुरुषोत्तम कुमार ने उपस्थित लोगों को सूचित किया कि 10 अगस्त से 27 अगस्त तक सरकार द्वारा आयोजित एमडीए (मास ड्रग एडमिनिस्ट्रेशन) कार्यक्रम के तहत सर्वजन दवा सेवन अभियान चलाया जाएगा। उन्होंने सभी उपस्थित लोगों से आग्रह किया कि वे अपने और अपने आस-पड़ोस के परिवारों को इस दवा का सेवन करने और करवाने के लिए प्रेरित करें। उन्होंने यह भी स्पष्ट किया कि इस दवा का सेवन पूरी तरह से सुरक्षित है और इससे कोई गंभीर दुष्प्रभाव नहीं होता। कुछ मामलों में हल्का बुखार या उल्टी हो सकती है, लेकिन इसके लिए घबराने की जरूरत नहीं है। नजदीकी अस्पताल में जाकर इन समस्याओं का समाधान किया जा सकता है। यह जागरूकता अभियान पीरामल फाउंडेशन और नालंदा जिले के एनजीओ फोरम के दिशा-निर्देशों के तहत चलाया जा रहा है। कार्यक्रम में विद्यालय के प्रधानाध्यापक दिलीप कुमार, शिक्षक राकेश बिहारी शर्मा, अनुज कुमार, अरविंद कुमार शुक्ला सहित अन्य शिक्षक भी उपस्थित थे। इस कार्यक्रम में विक्की कुमार, धनंजय सिंह और अन्य कार्यकर्ताओं ने भी महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका निभाई।

भामरागढ़ (त.सं.). महात्मा गांधी राष्ट्रीय रोजगार गारंटी योजना, भारत ग्रामीण आजीविका प्रतिष्ठान, एक्सिस बैंक फाउंडेशन व युवा रूरल एसोसिएशन संस्था भामरागढ़ के संयुक्त तत्वावधान में भामरागढ़ तहसील के इरकडुम्मे ग्राम अंतर्गत धुडेपल्ली में जल प्रबंधन प्रारूप गांव के लोगों के जनसहभाग से तैयार किया गया. इसके तहत गांव में शिवार फेरी का आयोजन किया गया था. इस माध्यम से गांव का जनसहभाग के जलप्रबंधन प्रारूप तैयार किया गया. शुरुआत में गांव के विकासकार्यों का मूल्यांकन किया गया. जल प्रबंधन प्रारूप तैयार करते समय युवा रूरल एसोसिएशन के उपजीविका तज्ञ अजय गावडे, क्षेत्रीय समनवयक आबिद शेख, सूचना प्रबंधिका स्नेहीता नागुलवार आदि उपस्थित थे.

गांव प्रमुख संन्याशी मत्तामी, रामजी आत्राम, पेका मत्तामी, आंगनवाड़ी सेविका रंजना मत्तामी, संगीता गावडे, शांता दुर्वा समेत नागरिक उपस्थित थे. इस समय प्रकल्प की जानकारी संपूर्ण गांव को दी गई. मनरेगा के कार्य से गांव का विकास कैसे होगा, इस संदर्भ में समझाया गया. किसानों की सिंचाई की सुविधा, स्रोत निर्माण करना, भूजल स्तर बढ़ाना इस विषय पर विस्तृत चर्चा कर प्रारूप तैयार किया गया. इसमें नए सिंचाई, पुराने कुएं पुनर्भरण गड्ढा, खेत तालाब, नए बोड़ी निर्माण करना, बोड़ी गहराईकरण, मजगी मरम्मत करना, मलबे का उपसा करना, बांध का निर्माण, पौधारोपण, बकरी पालन, मत्स्य पालन, कुक्कुट पालन, परसबाग आदि कार्यों के संदर्भ में नियोजन किया गया.
