बिहारशरीफ(नवशक्ति)। अस्थावां प्रखंड अंतर्गत मोहम्मदपुर पंचायत भवन में आंगनवाड़ी सेविका मुन्नी कुमारी की अध्यक्षता में एक महत्वपूर्ण बैठक का आयोजन किया गया। इस बैठक में अंतरराष्ट्रीय संस्था 'गूँज' के सहयोग से सामाजिक और आर्थिक विकास पर चर्चा की गई।

गूँज के प्रतिनिधि पुरुषोत्तम कुमार ने उपस्थित लोगों को संबोधित करते हुए बताया कि संस्था के राज्य प्रमुख शिवजी चतुर्वेदी के नेतृत्व में बिहार के कई जिलों के गांवों में समाज के हर वर्ग-बच्चों, पुरुषों, महिलाओं, किसानों, आंगनवाड़ी केंद्रों, विद्यालयों, और ग्रामीण चिकित्सकों के लिए सहयोग के प्रयास किए जा रहे हैं। संस्था ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों में आत्मनिर्भरता

सम्मानित किया जाएगा। इस बैठक में ग्राम नियोजन केंद्र संस्था के बिककी कुमार, राजो दास, दुखी महतो, योगेंद्र दास, रेखा देवी, रुबी कुमारी, जीविका की सीएम सुषमा कुमारी, अंबिका कुमार, अनीता देवी सहित दर्जनों लोग उपस्थित रहे। बैठक के दौरान कई सदस्यों ने अपने विचार साझा किए और इस पहल की सराहना की।
