बाल श्रम को रोकने के लिए व्यापक अभियान चलाया गया। उपायुक्त मनीष कुमार के निर्देश पर श्रम प्रवर्तन पदाधिकारी ने शहर के विभिन्न प्रतिष्ठानों में छापेमारी की। श्रम प्रवर्तन पदाधिकारी गिरीश चंद्र प्रसाद ने सभी प्रतिष्ठानों में धारा-12 क के तहत सूचना प्रदर्शित करवाई। उन्होंने स्पष्ट किया कि 14 वर्ष से कम उम्र के बच्चों से काम कराने वाले प्रतिष्ठानों पर 20 हजार रुपये का जुर्माना लगाया जाएगा। प्रवर्तन पदाधिकारी ने होटल, गैरेज और अन्य व्यावसायिक प्रतिष्ठानों के संचालकों से श्रम अधिनियमों का पालन करने का आग्रह किया। उन्होंने बताया कि बाल श्रम रोकने के लिए जिले में निरंतर कार्रवाई जारी रहेगी। इस अभियान में जन लोक कल्याण परिषद के प्रोजेक्ट इंचार्ज, चाइल्ड लाइन के सदस्य, एक्सेस टू जिस्टस के सदस्य और अन्य कर्मचारी शामिल रहे।
