जनपद गोंडा अठारह वर्ष की उम्र तक सभी बच्चों को अनिवार्य और मुफ्त शिक्षा 2030 तक देश से बाल विवाह के खात्मे में निर्णायक भूमिका निभा सकती है। देश में बाल विवाह के खिलाफ जारी लड़ाई में परिवर्तनकारी साबित हो सकने वाला यह अहम निष्कर्ष देश में 2030 तक बाल विवाह के खात्मे के लिए अभियान चला रहे 160 गैरसरकारी संगठनों के गठबंधन बाल विवाह मुक्त भारत अभियान द्वारा अंतरराष्ट्रीय महिला दिवस के अवसर पर जारी एक शोधपत्र "एजुकेट टू इंड चाइल्ड मैरिज: एक्सप्लोरिंग लिंकेजेज एंड रोल ऑफ एजुकेशन इन एलिवेटिंग एज ऐट मैरिज फॉर गर्ल्स इन इंडिया" में उजागर हुआ है। शोधपत्र के अनुसार, भारत बाल विवाह के 2030 तक खात्मे की राह में अपने लक्ष्य की ओर बढ़ रहा है। अध्ययन की अगुआई कर रहे पुरुजीत प्रहराज ने कहा, "यद्यपि स-रकारे बाल विवाह के खात्मे के लिए हढ़ इच्छाशक्ति से काम कर रही हैं, फिर भी यदि शिक्षा का अधिकार कानून में बदलाव कर 18 वर्ष तक शिक्षा अनिवार्य तथा निशुल्क कर दी जाए तो बेहतर होगा।
