2030 तक खाते की राह में अपने लक्ष्य की ओर बढ़ रहा है। अध्ययन की अगुआई कर रहे पुरुषीत प्रहराज ने कहा, "यद्यपि सरकार बाल विवाह के खाते के लिए दृढ़ इच्छाशक्ति से काम कर रही हैं, फिर भी यदि शिक्षा का अधिकार कानून में बदलाव कर 18 वर्ष तक शिक्षा अनिवार्य तथा निशुल्क कर दी जाए तो बेहतर होगा।
