

बाल विवाह से मानसिक व शारीरिक स्थिति पर पड़ता है दुष्प्रभाव : नूतन



बाल विवाह की रोकथाम को लेकर आयोजित कार्यशाला में उपस्थित जनप्रतिनिधि व अन्य .

बोआरीजोर. प्रखंड के देवीपुर पंचायत के सभागार भवन में बाल विवाह के रोकथाम को लेकर एक दिवसीय कार्यशाला का आयोजन किया गया. कार्यशाला का उद्घाटन पंचायत के मुखिया राजीना बेसरा ने किया. इस दौरान उन्होंने कहा कि बाल विवाह समाज के लिए एक अभिशाप है. इसे रोकना सभी का कर्तव्य बनता है. सभी के सहयोग से ही इस कुप्रथा को खत्म किया जा सकता है. उन्होंने कहा कि कार्यक्रम का आयोजन गर्ल्स फर्स्ट फंड एवं रास्ता संस्था के सहयोग से किया गया. इसके लिए सभी सदस्य बधाई के पात्र हैं. कार्यक्रम में उपस्थित नूतन कुमारी ने कहा कि बाल विवाह को रोकने के लिए कई तरह के कानून

बनाये गये हैं. इसके बावजूद फिर भी बाल विवाह हो रहा है या अत्यंत ही दुखद है. कम उम्र में बच्चों के विवाह होने से पति-पत्नी दोनों के मानसिक एवं शारीरिक स्थिति पर बुरा प्रभाव पड़ता है. उन्होंने कहा कि समाज के सभी व्यक्तियों को आगे बढ़कर इस कुप्रथा को रोकना होगा, ताकि एक स्वस्थ समाज बन सके. कार्यक्रम के दौरान कई कानूनी जानकारी भी दी गयी. इसे रोकने के लिए चाइल्ड लाइन हेल्पलाइन नंबर 1098 पर जानकारी देने को कहा गया तथा कहा गया कि फोन करने वाले व्यक्ति के नाम को गोपनीय रखा जाएगा. मौके पर प्रमिला, रितेश कुमार, उषा कुमारी, मेरी किस्कू आदि उपस्थित थे.
